He is the invisible host of Mi Señal Territorio Mágico, the new initiative of RTVC – Señal Colombia to accompany colombian children in a lover, effectiver and more direct way during the social isolation period. This programming slot (7:00 to 13:00) includes the educative and cultural shows produced for children by Señal Colombia, four sections where kids can participate sharing videos about their daily life (Historias osadas / Daring stories), positive and curious news (El correo de los magos / Magician’s mail), interesting facts to motivate their affection to knowledge (El increíble profesor web / The incredible Web Teacher) and one section dedicated to solve their questions about Covid-19 (Desbaratando el Coronavirus/ Falling apart Coronavirus). It also has animated sketches of Angustín’s monster world and the real world of a guest (children or grown up) who interact and have fun from the distance. Both, guest and host, accompany kids to wake up, have breakfast, do exercise, study and learn, lounge in bed and ‘keep in shape’ the muscle of imagination.”
